### From the Barkery

#### WHELPING ENERGY TREATS

I came up with this recipe a few years ago to give whelping mothers the <u>much needed energy</u> between whelps and the needed calcium to help the uterus contract more efficiently.

\*Please Note: Feed one to two treats ONLY AFTER first pup has been delivered. Subsequently, give one or two treats in between each whelp (if longer than one hour between whelps). Maximum 6 treats PER entire whelping time table.



#### Ingredients

- 2 Cups of old fashioned oatmeal
- **>** 1 Egg
- ▶ 2 tbsp Quality Local Honey
- 1 Can of Sweetened Condensed Milk

#### **Directions:**

- O Cook oatmeal according to package directions, enough to make 2 cups. Remove from heat.
- Once oatmeal has thickened and while still hot, add the egg, stirring well. You'll see the egg actually becomes scrambled into the hot oatmeal.
- Add the honey and entire can of sweetened condensed milk and stir until all ingredients are uniform.
- Let cool down for 15 minutes.
- o Spoon into Silicone trays or small muffin tins. (We use bone and paw shape silicone trays purchased from Amazon).
- Freeze in trays for 24 hours. Remove from trays and place into zip-lock freezer bags. Keep frozen until ready to feed.
